The **Soil and Water Assessment Tool (SWAT)** is a public domain model jointly developed by USDA Agricultural Research Service (USDA-ARS) and Texas AgriLife Research, part of The Texas A&M University System (TAMUS). SWAT is a river basin-scale model to simulate the quality and quantity of surface and ground water and predict the environmental impact of land management practices on different soil patterns and land use patterns. SWAT is widely used in assessing soil erosion prevention and control practices, non-point source pollution control methods and regional management in watersheds.


'SWAT Workshop and Conference' has been organized successfully in many countries in the past decade. The diagram (next page) shows where and when these events took place or will take place

SWAT model has been popular due to the fact that the model is in the public domain and it has ability to simulate a watershed of any size, from a small watershed of few ha to an area of a large continent. Therefore there is substantial demand from scientific communities to learn about its application in various conditions.
